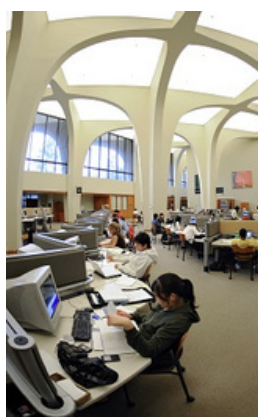

Program Instructors

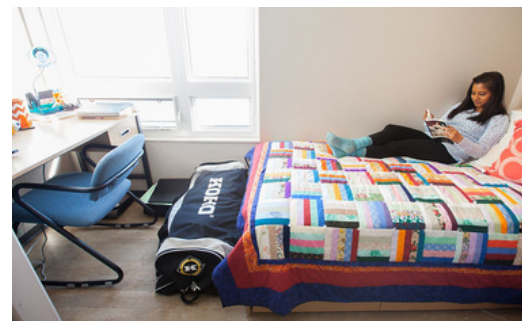
All program instructors are highly educated in teaching English as an additional language with extensive professional experience to provide high-quality programs designed to meet specific needs.

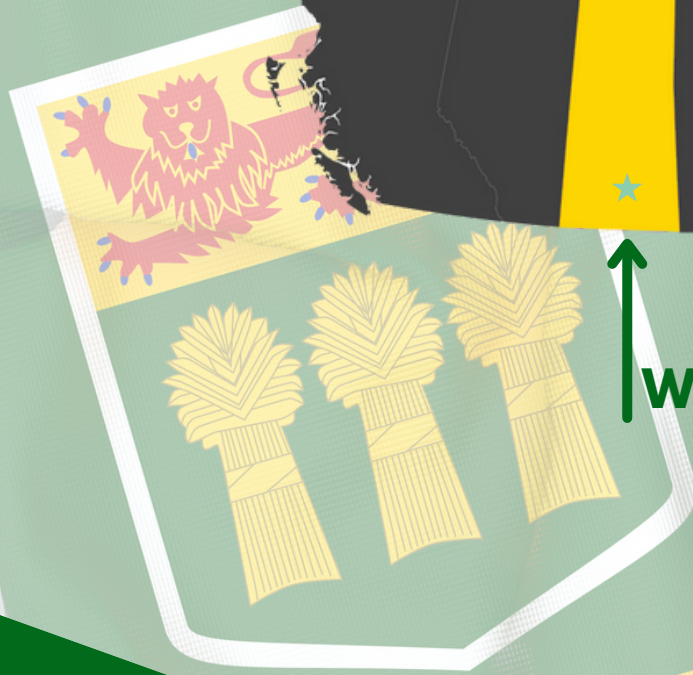
